Scouting Community Week Challenge Sunday 2nd June District HQ, Poplars 10:30am until 3pm.



As an introduction, to the start of Scout Community Week, the Beavers will be having a recycling junk craft morning and a sausage sizzle, followed by a litter pick in Ridlins Woods.

The beavers will start off at 10:30am at the District HQ at Poplars with a junk modelling session. They can, if they wish, bring a carrier bag in for this session, though some junk will be provided. Also during this time they will be learning about recycling, which is part of their challenge badge.

At lunch they will then be stopping for a sausage sizzle.

In the afternoon they will be walking to Ridlins Wood, where they will be completing a litter pick. Once completed, they will be walking back to the District HQ where they can be picked up 3pm.

Any beaver attending will be able to complete their 'B&Q Do 1 Thing' badge, as well as a couple of parts towards their challenge badges.

The cost of the day will £4, which will include the cost of the Community Week badge, activities and lunch.
