Past Events

Scouting Community Day - Stevenage

A fantastic day was had by over 100 youngsters and over 70 adults, as we worked together to tidy up and clear around the new District Activity Centre. We were joined by the Mayor, County representatives and District members to celebrate the opening of this new resource for Stevenage District Scouting. After all the hard work, the youngsters settled down for a BBQ and drink, followed by a campfire, in the newly built campfire circle.



County Beaver Pirate Fun Day

Over 50 youngsters joined over 800 beavers and leaders from Hertfordshire at Tolmers Campsite for a day of Pirate fun, which included craft activities such as making flag, eye patches, swords, badges and hats. They also run along inflatables, bounced on castles, jumped on trampolines and walked with pirates. During lunch break, they watched a theatre company perform Treasure Island in an open air stage. During the afternoon more activities continued for the beavers to take part in, before a lot of very quiet, tired beavers got back on the coaches to Stevenage.

District Cub Camp - August 9th to 15th, 2015

This is open to any cub, who has been invested into cubs, before the start of July 2015. The camp will cost £205, for a week long trip including trips to Brownsea Island, Blandford Army Camp, Moors Valley Country Park, Steam Railway, laserquest, swimming pool, beach, Adventure Wonderland and onsite activities.

Mayor's Presentation Evening – Fri 26th Sept.

JOTA – Sat 18th October - District HQ, Poplars

The activities will all be based around communication, code breaking and making; speaking in foreign languages; non-verbal communication and signalling.
